- 1. When Cady/Katie regains consciousness at the beginning of the book, how can you tell she managed to remain calm? How would you handle yourself in the same situation?
- 2. How did Cady/Katie manage to function while her memories were gone? Would you be able to keep going if you didn't know anything about yourself?
- 3. Why did it surprise her when she could do things like martial arts or driving a car?
- 4. If you were Ty, would you have helped Cady/Katie? Why or why not?
- 5. Have you ever tried to fool someone by dressing very differently and changing your hair? How did it go?
- 6. Why did they trust Aunt Elizabeth? Or did they? Were they prepared to go up against her if they needed to?
- 7. Have you, or anyone you know, ever been hacked on Facebook? What could you do about it?
- 8. Is this the kind of book you enjoy reading? What other titles would you recommend for people who like mystery/suspense/on-the-run stories?
- 9. Do you have a GPS in your car or on your phone? Have you used it?
